Schedule of Events

Friday July 26, 2024 - Entries will be accepted at Arts in the Sunset, 3701 Plains Blvd., Amarillo, TX, between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. Permission required for early entries. Call 806.354.8802.

August 1-2, 2024 - Judging of entries and hanging of show.

Friday, August 9, 2024 - Awards ceremony held during the All Things Artful Art Festival at 7 p.m. in the atrium.

Monday, September 16, 2024- Pick up all works between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. (pieces not picked up by September 30 become property of the Amarillo Art Institute)

Awards

Best of Show - \$350

First in each Category - \$200

Second in each Category - \$100

Third in each Category - \$50

The Best of the Southwest Summer Show will be held at Arts in the Sunset. The reception will coincide with the Amarillo Art Institute's All Things Artful Art Festival, which begins at 6 p.m. Each artist will receive one free ticket to the Festival, and additional tickets can be purchased by the participating artist for \$15 (regular tickets cost \$25)

Best of Show will not be eligible for an additional award. Honorable Mentions - Three in each category, at the Judge's discretion. No artist can sweep a category, if the judge awards an artist 1st, 2nd, and 3rd, the 3rd place will go to the piece in 4th place. Please arrange for someone to pick up your award and work if you cannot be present by September 16, 2024.

Categories

Oil, Acrylic, Photography, 3-Dimensional Sculpture, Ceramics (Pottery), Watercolor, Drawing (charcoal, colored pencil, markers, pen and ink, etc.), Mixed Media (encaustic, textiles, collage, etc.), Pastels, and Digital Media (3D Printing, Graphic Design, etc.). Pieces with a predominant media will be placed in that media and is up to the discretion of AAI. ANY Category receiving less than 7 entries will receive 1st place only, and in some cases with only a few entries a category may be combined with another. Each artist may enter 1-4 works. No more than 4 entries per artist will be accepted. The entry fee is \$15 per entry or \$50 for 4 entries.

Eligibility

- All work submitted must be the original work of the artist – conceived, designed and completed by the artist. Source materials must be available upon request.
- No work from kits, molds, patterns, or copies of other artists' work, or copyrighted materials will be exhibited.
- There will be no diptychs, triptychs, or multiple ceramic items accepted as one entry (does not include lids to pottery positioned on pottery)
- **All work must have been completed in the past 12 months.**

Specifications

- All work must be **dry and gallery ready with wire hangers**. No saw-tooth hangers will be accepted.
- If Plexiglass is used, make a note of such on the front of the work.
- Works shall not exceed 72 inches in any direction, including any frames.
- Artist's name must be covered with tape. Tape will be removed after judging.
- Mixed media should be entered in the category of the most dominant media.
- Photographs mounted on foam core will not be accepted without a frame.
- All pieces must be presented in a way that can be hung professionally, frames where appropriate, no tape on wire hangers, no visible staples.
- The label must be filled out completely and taped to the back top, or on the bottom of 3D works.
- Works entered, must remain in the show, until the specified take-down date, September 13, 2023

Sales

- Works may be for sale or indicate NFS (not for sale) on the entry form.
- For the duration of the show, a 10% commission will be charged on all sales with checks made payable to the Amarillo Art Institute.

Liability

- Amarillo Fine Arts Association and the Amarillo Art Institute disclaim any responsibility for loss or damage. All works will be handled with utmost care. However, AFAA and AAI and/or any member of any entity shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage.
